The family is called the Domestic Church: This means that it is in the context of the family that we first learn who God is and to prayerfully seek His will for us. Religious Education at St. John's Church—2019-20

Catechesis of the Good Shepherd (CGS)

This is a Montessori-based religious formation program for children ages 3-5. It seeks to create and facilitate a sacred, "hands-on" space for the children called an atrium, in which both the children and their catechist can hear, ponder, and celebrate the most essential mysteries of the Christian faith as revealed in the Scriptures and the Liturgy. Class is limited to the first 12 children who register. Classes: Sunday morning.

Encounter with Christ Reconciliation/First Communion

Encounter with Christ Reconciliation (2nd grade) helps children reflect on practical ways to live as disciples, drawing upon the graces received in the sacraments. *Encounter with Christ Eucharist* centers on our immersion into Christ's Pascal Mystery, beginning with Baptism and deepened by active participation in the sacraments.

Alive in Christ

Alive in Christ (K-1st, & 5th grade) is built on a spiral curriculum that integrates seven central doctrinal themes (*Revelation, Trinity, Jesus Christ, The Church, Morality, Sacraments, and Kingdom of God*) of Church teaching. *Alive in Christ* teaches children to know, love, and live their Catholic faith through Scripture, doctrine, and prayer.

The Catholic Children's Bible

(3rd & 4th grade) children receive this bible after their First Communion. Through 3rd and 4th grade the kids learn how to use the bible and learn about all the stories in the bible. They Read It, Live it and Love it.

Confirmation

We prepare youth of 12 years of age (sixth grade) for Confirmation, because it is a gift of the Holy Spirit. Exceptions to the normative age may only be granted by the bishop. This is a 2 year program. The youth are Confirmed the first year.

Faith Fusion

(7th & 8th grade) Faith Fusion brings the Catholic Faith to life in words and images, and provides a complete overview of the Faith built on the framework of the Catechism of the Catholic Church. Each lesson provides a direct connection between faith and life—between knowing, believing, and living.

Parent Information

- I will bring my child to Mass on Sundays and Holy Days of Obligation.
- I will allow my child to participate in the Safe Environment Training and make every attempt to have them attend classes every Sunday or Wednesday for High School.
