Bishop Gruss announces this week that our Catholic Diocese has entered in a purchase agreement with Black Hills Federal Credit Union, for the building at 255 Main. It will be renovated over the next year or so, with a chapel and offices conducive for the ministry of Jesus (see the picture on the front bulletin board.) There is one campaign through our West River Diocese, which includes the needs of a Rapid City Catholic School. Please read the insert for testimonies.

St. John's parish goal is \$355,000. When it is reached with cash deposited, St. John's receives 20%. The parish council, discerning our mission, sees 3 needs: a) Retiring the debt of the heating/cooling system, b) replacing church carpeting, and c) leadership training for Catechesis of the Good Shepherd and other catechesis.

Next weekend, we'll ask you to come to Padre Hall for 15 minutes after the mass you attend. We'll show the video, and ask you to consider a sacrificial gift. What could you give over a 5 year time span for these diocesan ministries? Those pledges could be turned in anytime; we'll ask specifically on the February 10 and 24 weekends.

LORD, we turn to you with joy in our hearts, for all that we have and are comes from you.

Guide us to become good stewards of the many gifts you have given us. Make Living The Misson a true labor of love for all of us so that our local Church may be strengthened. Give us generous and sacrificial hearts following Your example, providing for our brothers and sisters who are the Church in western South Dakota. Inspire us to build a lasting legacy of faith, so that we, and the generation to follow, will ever more joyfully, boldly and lovingly proclaim and live the mission of Jesus Christ, leading to eternal life.
