A Framework For Understanding The Bible

Reading the Bible brings vitality to our Christian life. The good news of Jesus gives faith

when we are lost, hope in days of discouragement, and love to guide our lives. To see an overview of the history of salvation, can give perspective to what we read. The 12 headings of this study guide summarize the story of God revealing His love and our ancestors' response. The psalms listed help understand and pray about the meaning for disciples today. (Fr. Ron Garry's guide) As you read and search for understanding, ask:

- (1) What happened during the event?
- (2) What did it mean then?
- (3) What does it mean now: in my own walk with the Lord? in our Catholic life together? in current events of the world?
