Sacrifice Bean Jar Set: A Lent / Easter family activity, with Black Beans and Jelly Beans! Everything you need for a powerful Lenten activity for children! Empty the first jar and put the black beans in a bowl beside the jar. Every time a child performs a sacrifice or good deed, he or she gets to add a black bean to the jar! On Easter morning, replace the number of black beans with jelly beans. During the Easter season, one jelly bean gets to be eaten for every good deed done!

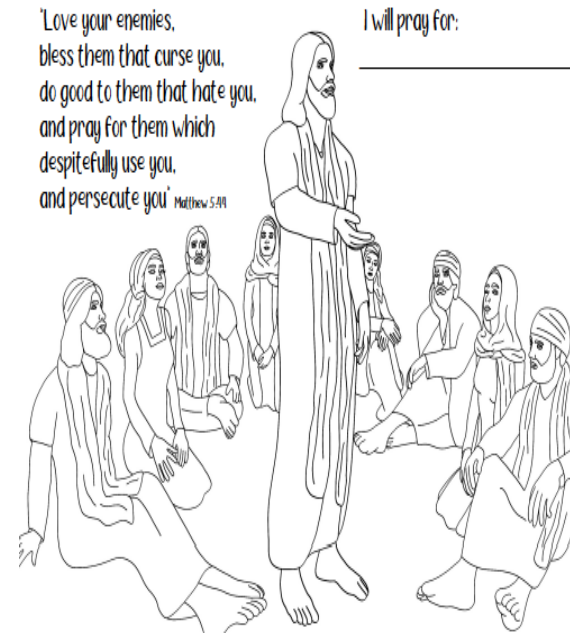

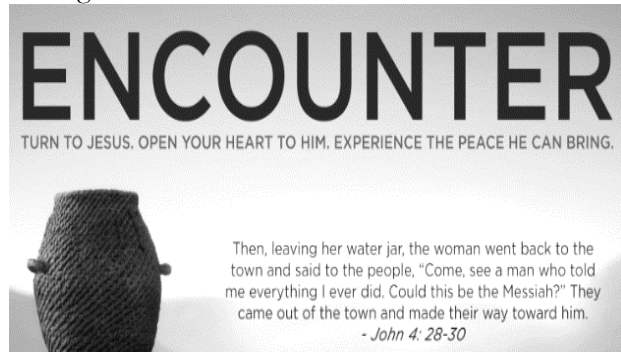

during Lent ... **Abstain** from meat on **Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, all Lenten Fridays.**

Required by all Catholics 14 years of age and older.

Fast on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday:** all Catholics 18 -59 years old.

Those bound by this discipline may take only one full meal; 2 smaller meals are permitted to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted. To imitate the 40 days in the desert of Jesus, as he began his public ministry, the church from its earliest days urged the baptized and the catechumens to observe fasting, almsgiving, and prayer. Failure to observe individual days of penance is not considered serious, but failure to observe any penitential days at all during Lent is objectively seriously wrong. "Take up your cross and follow me."
