



Although perhaps not a familiar sight for the past 50 years or so in the United States, Eucharistic Processions on the Feast of Corpus Christi have been held for over 600 years and have been an integral part of Catholic culture and practice in many countries. "Processions can be a powerful way to renew and rediscover both belief in the real presence of Jesus in the Eucharist as well as the missionary call that every Catholic shares: to bring Jesus to the world." (*Knights of Columbus Procession Guide*).

Those participating in a **Eucharistic Procession** proclaim by their actions their desire to follow Jesus and share Him with those around them. Processions provide an opportunity to encounter Christ and deepen their faith. As mass concludes about 6:10pm, we'll walk behind the Blessed Sacrament to the Jesus & John Baptist statue next to Hwy. 83, and pray for about 7 minutes in adoration, silence, and receiving Benediction:

As Peter said to You, Lord Jesus, help our unbelief; make our hearts wholly united with Yours, in adoration and in service. Unite us as a church by the Holy Spirit. Give us courage to witness to our faith in the unbelief of our age, and to invite those who have left the practice of the faith to be renewed in You. May the heart of Jesus, in the Most Blessed Sacrament, be praised, adored, and loved with grateful affection, at every moment, in all the tabernacles of the world, even to the end of time. Amen.

This great Sacrament we hail;  
Over ancient forms of worship  
Newer rites of grace prevail;

To the everlasting Father,  
And the Son who made us free,
