



DUC IN ALTUM 2023

(Latin for “Put out into the deep” – Luke 5:4) is a Summer Catechetical and Evangelistic Program for Children and Youth

Grade School (Gr. 1-6): Monday -Thursday 9:00am-2:30pm

Middle and High School (Gr. 7-12): Sunday-Thursday 7:00pm-9:00pm

The cost is **\$20.00** per child or **\$50.00 per family**.

Duc in Altum is a diocesan program that gathers together college students and seminarians into teams of four each and sends them out to parishes to spread the GOOD NEWS of our LORD among children and youth. For grade school children, the program consists in catechetical instruction, songs, games, daily Mass, the Sacrament of Reconciliation, lunch, recess and more. *Duc in Altum* balances strong catechetical content with having FUN!

The middle and high school program has catechetical instruction, a night of Eucharistic Adoration and Reconciliation and fellowship with the team. The goal of both programs is to help them to know the LORD and love him more deeply. Because of the youthfulness and energy of the teachers the children and youth have FUN as well!

The grade school children are asked to bring any recess equipment they may want to use for recess. All are invited to a parish potluck on Thursday evening at 6:00pm to meet the team, learn about the content of the program, ask questions, and hear the children sing some songs. 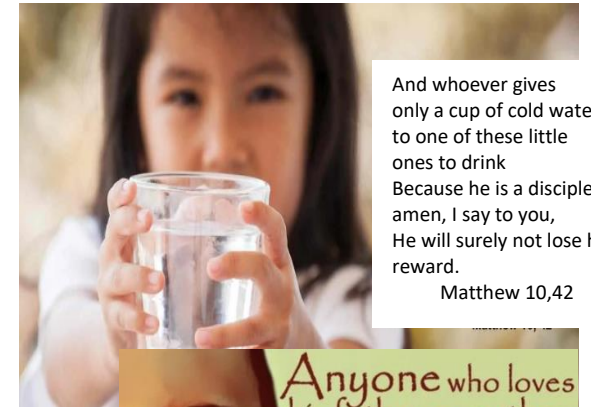

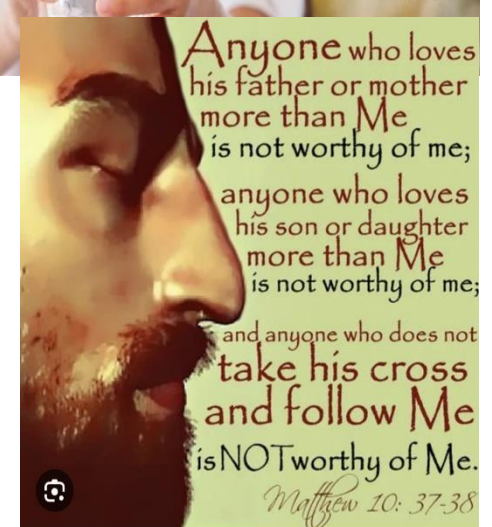

Veritatis Splendor Institute (VSI) is beginning this fall. Named for Pope St. John Paul II's great encyclical, *The Splendor of Truth*, its goal is to form disciples who engage in the work of evangelization, proclaiming the Gospel to all people. VSI better equips people for ministry and sharing the Faith with others – whether that be in a parish ministry setting or whether it is ministering to your children and family. VSI offers a Basic Level Certification (one-year program), and a Master Level Certification (two-year program, after completion of Basic Certification), with courses offered once a month on Saturdays, running September through June. The deadline for registration is August 8, 2023.

Also offered will be “**Pastoral Enrichment Certifications**” on various VSI Saturdays throughout the year. These will be a one-day-only seminar, in which participants will receive formation on a particular topic for ministry. 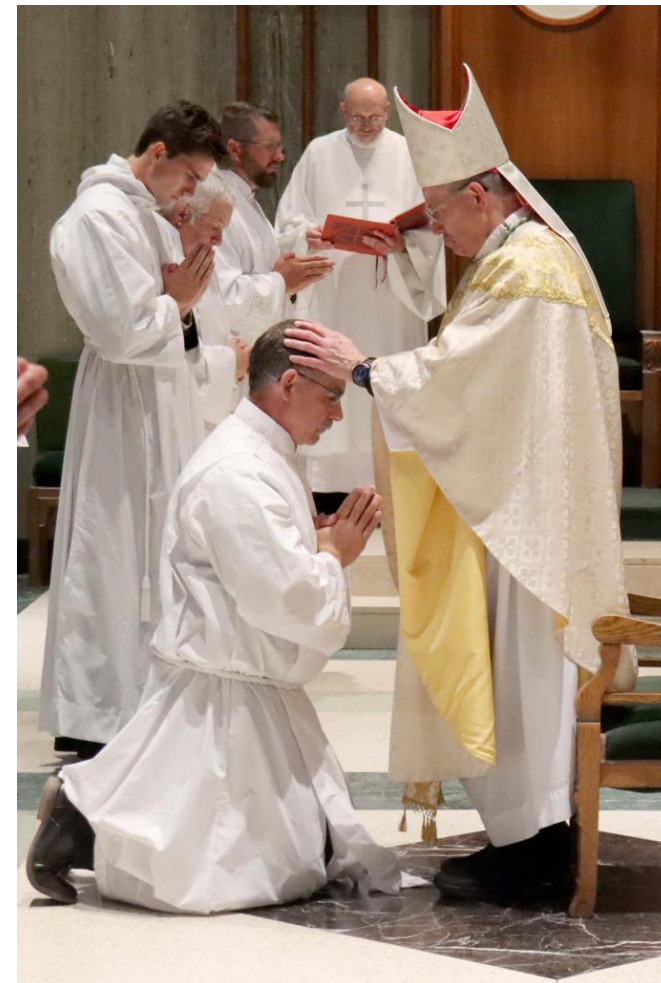
Thursday night Bishop Muhich ordained six married men to be permanent deacons, and one as transitional on way to priestly ordination in 6 months.
