

**November we pray for the Church suffering in purgatory**

Loving God, source of all consolation, by the death and resurrection of Jesus we hope for eternal life. We remember our loved ones who have died, for we miss them. We pray they rejoice in Your glory forever. We offer our sacrifices for those in purgatory. We remember them in hope of being reunited in paradise, for we know that death is not the last word. For all those whose faith has strengthened the Church throughout the ages, we give You thanks. May Your Holy Spirit keep us faithful to our baptismal promises in every moment, in prayer and deeds. Amen.

Pray when you pass by a cemetery, or remember those deceased. *Catechism of the Catholic Church* #1031 The Church gives the name Purgatory to this final purification of the elect, Purgatory exists! The Scriptures speak of a cleansing fire after death (see 1 Corinthians 3:15, 1 Peter 1:7, and Matthew 12:32). Purgatory exists because of God's love for us. Purgatory isn't a punishment. The primary pain of the souls in purgatory is the loss of the sight of God. Purgatory isn't a physical fire.

**Parish Council met** on 1 November 2022, 6:10-7pm in Padre Hall. Present were Judy Weisgram, Kelly Madsen, Laura Hand, Mary Fravel, Fr. Ron Garry. Absent Jess Holt. We have been preparing a new wording for parish council constitution and by laws. We also looked at the Diocesan Strategic Planning presentation: Flourishing Families. Ron still looks for one to discern what should be included in the parish website content and formatting. That will be one of our standing committees in the days to come. We will look to parish council elections in January 2023.
