

 toward peace and rest in mind, body, and soul through
 Catholic prayer. It has beautiful prayers, faithful meditations,
 daily devotionals, and nourishing Scripture: It is a way you
 can deepen trust in God.

The **All Souls' Day indulgence** is obtained by devoutly
 visiting a church or a cemetery, and reciting an Our Father
 and the Creed. A recent Vatican announcement allows the
 faithful to gain plenary indulgences for the souls in purgatory
 by visiting a cemetery on any eight days in November - which

need not be consecutive - and praying for
 those who have died; normally, the
 indulgence is limited to the first eight days
 of the month. The elderly, sick, and all
 those who for serious reasons cannot
 leave their home will also be able to
 obtain the indulgence by joining
 spiritually with the faithful. The usual
 conditions for plenary indulgence apply:
 + going to confession (*in this extended
 situation, once a week*), + resolving to remain
 in state of grace, + receiving the
 Eucharist, and + praying for the
 intentions of the pope.
